


Confidential Immunizations in the IIS


Patients may request their vaccinations be marked as confidential in their IIS immunization record. Vaccinations marked as confidential will still appear on the patient's Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS), as well as the consumer application MyIR. However, a Patient Record can be printed from the IIS that does not include confidential information or confidential vaccines.

How do I mark a vaccination as confidential in the IIS?

When adding/editing a new or historical vaccination in the IIS, select the radio button next to the word **YES** to the right of the word **Confidential**.




Vaccinations that have been marked as confidential will show on the **Vaccine View/Add** page with a "C" as shown below.



How do I provide a vaccination record without showing the confidential vaccines?

If a patient has an immunization marked as confidential on their record, carefully consider whether to include those vaccines based on who is requesting the record.

1. After locating the patient record in this IIS, open the **Reports** menu tab on the left of the page. Click on **Patient Record**.




