Overall Goal of these meetings (from HB 1427)

Reduce the opioid epidemic in Washington State through the following two projects.

<p><u>No. 1: Opioid Prescribing Task Force:</u></p> <p><u>Purpose:</u> Acting as representatives from each board or commission, to develop consensus on rules related to opioid prescribing.</p> <p><u>Outcome:</u> A boilerplate set of prescribing rules that all boards and commissions form consensus on and agree to adopt.</p>	<p><u>No. 2: Prescription Monitoring Public Input Process:</u></p> <p><u>Purpose:</u> Collect input from the public and stakeholders to shape how DOH will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish an overdose notification message for providers; • Create standard prescribing metrics to be provided to facilities and groups; • Rules for all PMP elements of HB 1427.
