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### State revokes, suspends licenses, certifications, registrations of health care providers

**OLYMPIA** -- The Washington State Department of Health has revoked or suspended the licenses, certifications, or registrations of the following health care providers in our state. The department has also immediately suspended the credentials of people who have been prohibited from practicing in other states.

The department's Health Systems Quality Assurance Division works with boards, commissions and advisory committees to set licensing standards for more than 80 health care professions (e.g., dentists, nurses, counselors). Information about disciplinary action taken against medical doctors and physician assistants can be found on the <u>Washington Medical Commission (WMC) website</u>. Information about health care providers is on the agency's website. Click on "Look up a health care provider license" in the "How Do I?" section of the Department of Health home page (doh.wa.gov). The site includes information about a health care provider's license status, the expiration and renewal date of their credential, disciplinary actions and copies of legal documents issued after July 1998. This information is also available by calling 360-236-4700. Consumers who think a health care provider acted unprofessionally are also encouraged to call and report their complaint.

#### **Island County**

In December 2021 the Nursing Commission suspended the registered nurse license of **Kayla Erin Wilson** (RN60295492). Wilson failed to comply with a substance use monitoring program.

#### **King County**

In December 2021 the Nursing Commission and registered nurse **Jesi V. Villamarin** (RN00152833) entered an agreement that indefinitely suspended Villamarin's registered nurse license. Villamarin failed to comply with a substance use monitoring program.

#### **Thurston County**

In December 2021 the secretary of health indefinitely suspended the substance use disorder

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professional trainee license of **Chelsea R. Golias** (CO60816670). She had a sexual relationship with a patient she counseled at the Thurston County Jail where she worked.

## **Out of State**

**California:** In December 2021 the Nursing Commission suspended the license of registered nurse **Maggie Angulo Ong** (RN60502814). Ong surrendered her registered nursing license to the California Board of Registered Nursing after she was convicted of grand theft of personal property.

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
