



Health Equity Zones

Support for communities to improve health

The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) is working with community members and partners to identify Health Equity Zones. These are geographic areas that have poor health outcomes. They will receive special support from DOH and partners to improve community health.

A statewide Community Advisory Council will work together to identify the new Health Equity Zones by September 2022.

Nominate yourself or someone you know to join the Community Advisory Council

Member selection

If you are nominated or nominate someone else, you will be invited to help select council members at a December 8 virtual meeting

Meetings and time commitment

Selected council members will meet online monthly from January through September 2022, and commit about 6.5 hours to council work each month

Compensation

Council members will be compensated up to \$280/month

The council will lay the foundation for this important work

The council will include people from across the state. They will have different backgrounds and life experiences, but will share a common goal: building opportunities for everyone in our state to live a healthy life.
