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2022 Provider Agreement Renewal Schedule

Each year, providers must renew their Provider Agreement for continued participation in the Childhood Vaccine Program. Providers and state staff use the Washington State Immunization Information System (IIS) to complete the renewal process. Providers renew their agreements based on the county the provider is located in. All providers are required to renew their agreements by the end of April. We will offer communication and guides to help providers complete their 2022 agreement, and we will make current material available on our webpage. Please review the table below for your county’s renewal schedule.

A provider’s permission to order vaccine is suspended if a new agreement is not approved by the due date. Permission to order vaccine will be restored when a new agreement is approved.

At least three attempts are made to contact providers who do not complete their agreement renewal. If the provider does not complete their agreement within 30 days past the due date, the disenrollment process will begin. Extensions may be granted to providers who are attempting to complete an agreement and have an agreement status of “submitted”, “pending” or “returned.” Providers must contact the program to request an extension.
