

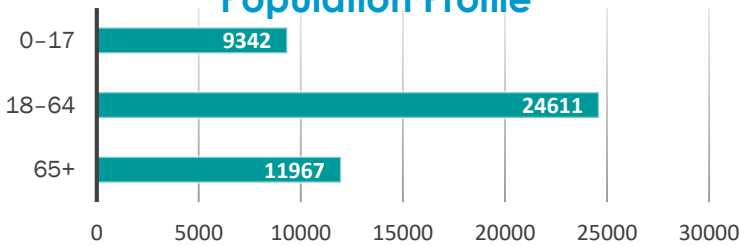
Washington Rural County Medicaid Workforce Report

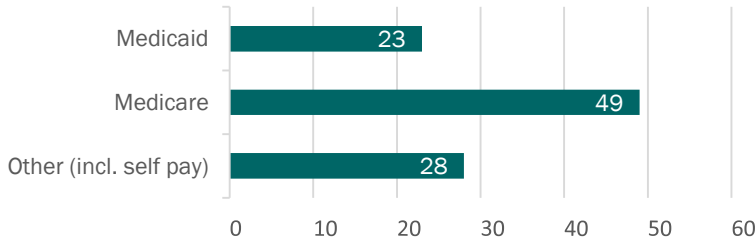

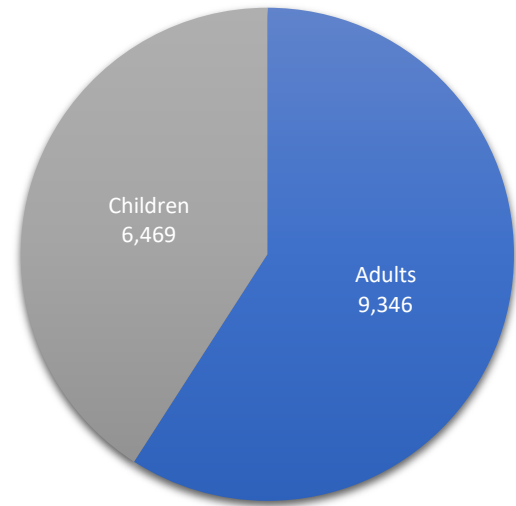
Hospital Payer Mix %

Stevens County At-a-Glance

Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSA)

Areas and populations in Washington are surveyed to determine if a shortage of HPSA eligible healthcare providers servicing low-income, disadvantaged populations exists. Areas with these designations receive a score based on factors gathered during a surveying process. These federal designations allow eligible facilities and providers access to numerous federal and state workforce incentive programs. There are three main categories: behavioral health, dental health and primary care.
