**Applicant:** Tri-City Orthopaedic Clinic

**Description of Proposal:** Tri-City Orthopaedic Clinic proposes to operate Tri-City Orthopaedic Kennewick Surgery Center as a CN-approved, 4-OR ASF at 6703 West Rio Grande Avenue, Suite A, Kennewick, WA 99336

**Estimated Costs:** The estimated capital expenditures is \$192,244.

**Public Hearing:** No public hearing will be conducted.

**Public Comment Period:** The Certificate of Need Program have declared a pivotal unresolved issue (PUI) on the application submitted by Tri-City Orthopaedic Clinic. This allows the Certificate of Need Program to reopen the record so it can obtain additional information before making its decision.

The program is requesting that Tri-City Orthopaedic Clinic provide documentation in response to the department's PUI letter dated December 3, 2021. Tri-City Orthopaedic Clinic will submit this information by Friday, January 7, 2022.

The deadline to receive the additional comments on this new information is Friday, January 21, 2022.
