# Timeline

**2/17/22** Governor announces plans for rescinding the mask mandate on 3/21/22.  
\*Updated 2/28/22 – mandate to be rescinded 3/12/22

**Week of 3/7/22**  
Updated DOH **School Guidance** will be released

**3/12/22** Mask mandate rescinds, and new guidance goes into effect



*Ahead of new guidance posting:*

- DOH Subject Matter Experts in outbreak response, testing, clinical, and environmental will draft changes to the guidance
- Workgroups in local health and industries will be consulted

*Ahead of new guidance going into effect:*

- Begin rollout of updated non-school guidance for the general public and most businesses

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# Governor Inslee Announcement on Masking Requirements

## State Indoor Mask Requirements Starting March 12 2022

Local governments are still able to enact local mask requirements.

Many individuals will choose to continue to wear masks. Please be kind and compassionate.



### Still Required:

- Healthcare and medical facilities, including hospitals, outpatient, dental facilities and pharmacies
- Long-term care settings
- Public transit, taxis, rideshare vehicles and school buses (federal requirement)
- Correctional facilities
- Private businesses and local governments that want to require masks for their employees, customers or residents



### \*Not Required:

- Schools, childcare facilities and libraries
- Restaurants and bars
- Houses of worship
- Gyms, recreation centers and indoor athletic facilities
- Grocery stores, businesses and retail establishments

\*Private businesses can still require masks if they choose. Please respect the rules of the room.

# Governor Inslee Announcement on Masking Requirements

Layered prevention strategies, like staying **up to date on vaccines and wearing masks**, can help prevent severe illness and reduce the potential for strain on the healthcare system – especially when levels of transmission are high. DOH is evaluating masking recommendations for additional high-risk setting.







# Vaccinations by Age Group

Coverage refers to the proportion of the population that has been appropriately vaccinated. The denominator used to calculate coverage is the 2020 population estimate from the Office of Financial Management. As of October 29th, under the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA), Moderna and Janssen vaccines are authorized for people 18 & older, and Pfizer vaccine is authorized for people 5 years of age and older. People whose age is 65 & above were made eligible early on and prioritized for vaccination, so this group has high coverage rates. Since the




Image description: Graph of People Initiating Vaccine (light blue) or Fully Vaccinated (dark blue) by age group.


# Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Updates

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- CDC recommendation would pave way for 18 million children to receive new vaccine
- Since March 2020, 1.5 million cases in children <5 years
- The medical home, primary care provider, and pediatrician should be primary setting for this age group
  - These are the trusted providers to notify, schedule, and vaccinate this population
- Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna are conducting clinical trials and data collection for COVID-19 vaccines for children ages 6m–4 years
- Pfizer-BioNTech has stopped submitting data to FDA for an Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) application for a vaccine for children ages 6m–4 years.
- Data were submitted for two doses of what is anticipated to be a three-dose series. Application has been pulled.

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


# Novavax seeks FDA emergency use authorization for COVID-19 vaccine

Jan. 31 (UPI) -- Novavax asked the Food and Drug Administration on Monday to grant an emergency use authorization for its protein-based COVID-19 vaccine.



The Novavax vaccine, which consists of two doses given 21 days apart, is currently used worldwide after being granted conditional authorization by the European Commission and the World Health Organization. If granted by the FDA, it would be the first protein-based COVID-19 vaccine to receive emergency use authorization in the United States.
