

Compliance with child care and early learning immunization requirements is critical to protecting Washington children from vaccine-preventable diseases.

THE IIS IMMUNIZATION MODULE

- The module is a feature of the Washington State Immunization Information System (IIS), an online registry of immunization records entered by health care providers for people of all ages in Washington State.
- The Module is a free, secure, and easy-to-use web-based tool that child care and early learning centers can use to track and manage the immunizations of children.

WHAT FEATURES DOES THE MODULE HAVE ?

- A Roster showing each child's immunization status for required immunizations.
- An Action Report showing which children need additional vaccines.
- Parent letters for children with missing immunizations.
- An at-risk report that quickly identifies vulnerable children during a disease outbreak.
- The ability to print a Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form for children in your care.

BENEFITS FOR CHILD CARES AND EARLY LEARNING CENTERS

- Acts a system for tracking and managing children's immunizations and exemptions.
- Provides access to provider-verified immunization data.
- Saves staff time tracking immunizations.
- Eliminates the need to fill out the annual immunization report.
- Allows staff to print a CIS for parents.
