Dear Dr. Slack:

This letter is in response to your Determination of Reviewability Ambulatory Surgery Center/Facility (ASF) request received on April 10, 2019. You requested that the department conduct a determination of reviewability of Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC pursuant to WAC 246-310-050(1).

A review of the department record shows that on May 1, 2018, it issued DOR #18-13 to Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC to establish one operating room ambulatory surgery center in Seattle. A comparison of the information used by the department when it issued DOR #18-13 to Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC, and the information in your April 10, 2018 application show that the facts relied upon by the department when it concludes that Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC operations does not require a Certificate of Need have not changed.

As a result, based on the totality of information presented in your May 1, 2018 and April 10, 2019 applications, the department concludes that the DOR #18-13 issued to Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC remains viable. This decision is not transferable.

**CHANGES THAT MAY EFFECT THIS DECISION**

If changes are made in the operation or ownership Sound Plastic Surgery, PLLC may no longer qualify for this decision. In that case, prior Certificate of Need review and approval or new determination of reviewability request would be required.

**APPEAL OPTION**

This decision may be appealed. You or any person with standing may request an adjudicative proceeding to contest this decision within 28 calendar days from the date of this letter. The notice of appeal must be filed according to the provisions of Revised Code of Washington 34.05 and Washington Administrative Code 246-310-610. A request for an adjudicative proceeding must be received within the 28 days at one of the addresses listed on the following page.


