Thank you for the e-mail requesting to withdraw the above referenced Certificate of Need applications submitted by Fresenius Medical Care for its project in Grays Harbor County. The application(s) propose to relocate Aberdeen Dialysis Center and add five dialysis stations at the new site.

Consistent with Washington Administrative Code 246-310-990, the department will refund Fresenius Medical Care a total of 75% of the submitted review fees. The table below shows the two review fees submitted for the project and the total amount to be refunded.
