On December 10, 2021, the Washington State Mental Health Counselors, Marriage and Family Therapists, and Social Workers Advisory Committee met online via Microsoft Teams. ## Open Session:

## 1. Call to Order - Michael Fitzpatrick, LMFT, Chair

- 1.1. Introductions The meeting was called to order at 9:10 a.m. Committee members, DOH staff, and visitors introduced themselves.
- 1.2. Agenda Motion to approve the amended agenda, seconded, vote 4-0.

### 2. Program Update – Brandon Williams, Program Manager

- 2.1. Program budgets There was an unusual number of disciplinary cases for the mental health counselor program that went to hearing and legal expenditures were higher than normal. Current program fund balances as of October 2021:
  - Marriage & Family Therapists: \$53,859Mental Health Counselors: (\$8,296)

- Social Workers: \$117,603

2.2. Credentialing Report - Mr. Williams presented the credentialing statistics for each program:

- 2.3. Committee member recruitment update Candidates have been interviewed and recommendations have been forwarded to the DOH secretary's office to fill vacancies for a marriage and family therapist, a mental health counselor, and a public member.
- 2.4. Rulemaking update Mr. Williams briefed the committee on the discovery of a previous revision of WAC 246-809 from 2018. He added that the committee had voted on accepting the revisions, but they were never implemented. He asked that the committee review those revisions and vote to include those changes in the current rulemaking effort (see item 4 below). In addition, Mr. Williams briefed the committee on a separate rulemaking effort to increase portability for licensees from other states looking to get licensed in Washington. That effort is being expedited and there will be a workshop and hearing that will be separate from the administrative rules revision.
- 2.5. 2022 legislative calls Mr. Williams asked committee members for volunteers to attend weekly calls from 830-9 a.m. for the duration of the legislative session to discuss and learn about legislation that could impact the programs. Mr. Apperson and Mr. Fitzpatrick volunteered to join the weekly calls.

2.6. Advanced suicide training update - The draft language is expected to be filed with the Office of the Code Reviser in January 2022 with public hearings to follow in late February or early March 2022. However, the department is still working on the model list for training and therefore licensees will not be required to comply as long as that is still pending.

The committee reviewed draft language for <u>Chapter 246-809 WAC</u> suggested revisions to comments that had been provided from a rules workshop that took place three years ago but were sidelined due to legislative implementation. *Motion to accept the draft version from 2018 with changes, seconded, vote 4-0.*
- 4.2. *Motion to close the rulemaking workshop, seconded, vote 4-0.*
