Re: Letter of Intent for Seattle Reproductive Medicine

Dear Mr. Hernandez:

In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Seattle Reproductive Medicine ("SRM") hereby submits this Letter of Intent to relocate its certificate of need ("CN") approved surgery center in Seattle from the fourth floor to the sixth floor within the existing building and convert its two procedure rooms to general operating rooms. The Seattle Reproductive Medicine Surgery Center ("SRSC") in Seattle is currently CN-Approved for three operating rooms, and thus the proposed project has no impact on the number of CN-Approved operating rooms within the planning area. Per WAC 246-310-080, the following information is provided:

1. Description of the proposed project

In 2016, SRM received CN approval to convert Seattle Reproductive Surgery Center in Seattle to a three operating room ambulatory surgery center consisting of one general operating room and two procedure rooms (CN1579). The proposed project includes the relocation from the fourth floor to the sixth floor at its current location and the conversion of its two procedure rooms to general operating rooms, for a total of three CN-approved general operating rooms.

2. Estimated cost of the proposed project:

The total estimated capital expenditures are \$10,487,012.

3. Description of the Service Area:

The Service Area is the King Central secondary health services planning area.
