In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Pacific Rim Outpatient Surgery Center (PROSC) herewith submits a letter of intent proposing to develop and operate a certificate of need (CN) approved ambulatory surgical facility (ASF) with five (5) operating rooms in Whatcom County.

1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:

PROSC currently operates an existing CN approved ASF in Whatcom County.¹ The current CN approved ASF is located at 3009 Squalicum Parkway, Bellingham, WA 98225.

The proposed project is to develop and operate a CN approved ASF with five (5) operating rooms at a new site.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:

The estimated capital expenditure is \$5,400,000.
