1. Call to Order – Elise Hutchison, Chair

Ms. Hardenbrook and Dr. Coryell briefed the committee on details regarding the Less Restrictive Alternative Program (LRA). LRA is outpatient treatment provided to an individual who meets criteria for commitment, but is not residing in a facility providing inpatient treatment.

Mr. Williams asked the committee to make a decision on the date to review <u>WAC 246-930</u> to identify areas that need to be revised. The committee agreed to meet on September 13, 2021 at 9 a.m.

The committee engaged in open discussion regarding issues of concern, including seeing a breakdown of the current licensure statistics (the Office of Customer Service has a large backlog and has been unable to provide reports due to the impact of the pandemic).
