1. Call to Order – Corey McNally, Acting Chair

- 1.1. Introductions –Mr. McNally called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Committee and agency staff members introduced themselves and their area of practice.
- 1.2. Approval of the September 13, 2021 meeting agenda. *Motion to approve the agenda, seconded, vote 6-0.*

The committee discussed ideas for generating more interest in the profession including using financial incentives to attract more behavioral health licensees, reducing licensure fees, and more outreach to students. Mr. Williams provided an update on the SOPB report, which will provide recommendations to the legislature on how to increase the number of SOTPs in the state. It was also mentioned that SB 6641 has created a barrier by requiring affiliate applicants to have a masters-level credential.
