



Due to decreased supplies of Monkeypox vaccine, and a need to ration; an alternate method for vaccine administration is available. The standard distribution method using Jynneos is to administer 0.5 mL subcutaneously. The alternate method is to deliver 0.1 mL intradermally.


To document this in PrepMod, begin in the Clinic Activity Form.

Scroll down to the list of patient names.


Select the “Vaccinated” radial button beside the patient’s name.



You will be directed to the page listing vaccines available for the clinic. Select the vaccine product on the far left, it will become highlighted with a blue check mark. To completely document the vaccination, use the scroll bar at the bottom of this section and scroll right for the remaining two fields “volume administered,” and “unit of measure.” Complete each field.

**Important Note:** To adjust the number by decimal points, it must be typed. The default adjustment for the up/down arrows in PrepMod “volume administered” column is in whole numbers. Please use keyboard entry for dosage information.

**PLEASE NOTE:** WAIS recognizes the Jynneos vaccine as a .5 mL dosage only. To decrement accurately against your WAIS inventory, manual entry in WAIS is required. Guidance for this will be posted on the [PrepMod Landing Page](#).
