

PrepMod Update

PrepMod was implemented in January 2021 a web-based software application that manages key aspects of COVID mass vaccination and reporting efforts. Influenza vaccinations were added in the fall of 2021.

In June 2022, DOH implemented PrepMod Enterprise, an updated version of the platform that offers new features and functionality. This includes the ability to incorporate additional non-COVID vaccination efforts.

PrepMod Monkeypox Clinics - Who should participate?

PrepMod is designed to support mass vaccination events (events where multiple patients are vaccinated the same time, often outside of the traditional health care setting.)

- **Existing Active PrepMod** organizations, will be able to utilize the new Monkeypox clinic type when it's implemented in early August 2022.
- **Previous PrepMod** organizations that are now deactivated (no longer actively using the system), will need to reach out to the PrepMod support team for technical guidance and review prior to using this system.
- **New organizations** who have not previously used PrepMod will be on-boarded on a case-by-case basis. The PrepMod application is designed specifically for agencies and organizations that **do not** have an existing electronic health record (EHR) interface to the Washington State IIS. Orgs must have an [WAIS Information Sharing Agreement](#) approved prior to using the system. PrepMod support staff at the Washington State Department of Health are available to discuss in more detail, including training requirements.
