Hepatitis B is a virus that infects the liver and can cause liver disease, cancer, and death. Many people who are infected don't know that they have the virus.

There is no cure, but the vaccine is safe and can protect from getting hepatitis B. You must complete the two or three-dose vaccine series to be fully protected.

Finding out early and getting care from a doctor is important to help you live a long and healthy life. Get tested and if at risk, get vaccinated.
