## **Applicants, Project Descriptions, Estimated Costs:**

<u>Pain Care Physicians, PLLC</u> owns and operates an ambulatory surgery center located at 155 Lilly Road Northeast, Suite B, in Olympia [98503] that currently has two operating rooms and operates under an exemption from Certificate of Need review. Surgeries currently provided are pain management. The application proposes to expand the types of surgeries provided at the surgery center to include: plastic surgery, podiatry, and orthopedics. The estimated capital expenditure for this project is zero.

<u>MultiCare Health System</u> proposes to construct an ambulatory surgery center at 601 McPhee Road Southwest in Olympia [98502] The application proposes construct the facility with two operating rooms. The types of surgeries to be provided include: ENT, gastroenterology, general surgery, gynecology, neurology, vascular surgery, podiatry, and urology. The estimated capital expenditure for this project is \$5,403,772.
