In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Soundcare, Inc. hereby submits a letter of intent proposing to reopen 36 banked skilled nursing home beds previously associated with Nisqually Valley Care Center, which were banked in July of 2018 under the provision of RCW 70.38.115 (13). Nisqually Valley Care Center was located in Pierce County. Soundcare, Inc. proposes to reopen these beds in a new facility in Puyallup, Pierce County. In conformance with WAC 246-310-080, the following information is provided:

1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:

Soundcare, Inc. proposes to reopen and operate 36 nursing home beds that were previously banked under full facility closure provisions. The beds will be located in a to be constructed facility in Puyallup.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:

The estimated capital cost of the proposed skilled nursing home facility in Puyallup is \$17,700,675.

3. Description of the Service Area:

The service area is Pierce County.
