

EBT Equipment Options for SNAP Produce Rewards Farm Vendors

Direct Marketing Farmers "farm vendors" participating in SNAP Produce Rewards are eligible for free EBT equipment through the organizations below. Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) is a system for using Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits. SNAP benefits are distributed in the form of an EBT card like a debit card and require a PIN number to use. SNAP customers should not be asked to share their PIN number, and SNAP authorized retailers should not keep PIN numbers on file.

Wireless terminal connects via AT&T Wi-Fi cellular service towers. Terminal only processes SNAP transactions and cannot process debit/credit card transactions. Must provide paper customer receipts with every transaction. Receipt printer is integrated within the equipment (Vendors are not compensated for the cost of printer paper.
