Grant County Public Hospital District No. 2, dba Quincy Valley Medical Center (QVMC) here within submits this letter of intent for the replacement of the current hospital.

- A. **Description of the Services Proposed.** QVMC is a 10 bed Critical Access Hospital (CAH), located in Quincy, Grant County. Following a recent election wherein the voters approved a bond to fund the project, QVMC proposes to replace the current hospital building. It will be replaced on the current property. There is no proposed increase in licensed beds, and no tertiary services are proposed. At project completion, the current hospital building will most likely be demolished.
- B. **Estimated Cost of the Proposed Construction.** The capital expenditure is estimated at \$55,000,000.
- C. **Description of Service Area.** The District's boundaries include Quincy and communities immediately contiguous. Consistent with the Department of Health's acute care hospital bed need methodology, the planning area for this project is Grant County.
