Open Session:

1. Opening of Public Meeting – Kenneth Pimpleton, Chair

- 1.1. Call to Order Mr. Pimpleton called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.
- 1.2. Meeting Format The governor's proclamation that temporarily rescinded parts of the OPMA regarding in-person meetings has been rescinded. However, the committee still consider it is unsafe to meet in-person and agreed to meet virtually. *Motion to approve, seconded, vote 6-0.*
- 1.3. Agenda Approval for September 9, 2022 and December 2, 2022. *Motion to approve, seconded, vote 6-0.*
- 1.4. Approval of Regular Meeting Minutes from February 11, 2022 and June 3, 2022 *Motion to approve, seconded, vote 6-0.*

2. Public Comment – Kenneth Pimpleton, Chair

There was no public comment.

3. Management Report – Ted Dale, Program Manager

- 3.1. <u>Budget Report</u> Mr. Dale briefed the committee on the budget for the SUDP program. The current fund balance is -\$478,948 and has been steadily dropping.
- 3.2. <u>Credentialing Report</u> Ms. Drake briefed the committee on the credentialing statistics as of November 2022. For the SUDP certification, there are 2,970 active licenses and 224 pending applications. For the SUDPT certification, there are 1,449 active licenses and 81 pending applications.
- 3.3. <u>2023 Legislative Calls</u> The 2023 session of the Washington State Legislature begins the second week of January. Mr. Dale called for volunteers to attend weekly legislative calls that DOH hosts for the duration of the legislative session. Ms. Adkison and Ms. Cherry volunteered to represent the committee.

4. Assistant Attorney General Report – Kristi Knieps, AAG

Ms. Knieps had no update to report to the committee.

5. Rulemaking Update – Ted Dale, Program Manager

- 5.1. Apprenticeship Program Mr. Dale informed the committee that the implementation of the program has been completed, however the approval process and application will be revisited at a future committee meeting to finalize those items.
- 5.2. Various Rulemaking Revisions A CR-101 was filed to update the following WAC subchapters and workshops were held in December 2023 to gather public comment:
 - WAC 246-811-300 Removing the reference to AIDS education as the statutory authority for that requirement was repealed by HB 1551 in 2020.
 - WAC 246-811-076 Adding pharmacists as a profession eligible for the alternative path, which allows members of listed healthcare professions to become credentialed after completing limited SUD-specific education and experience.

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> WAC 246-811-070 – Removal of the requirement that the department verify the coursework of nationally certified applicants, as verifying coursework presents a significant and recurring barrier for providers coming from other states.
