Dear Tribal Leader:

I am writing today to provide information about the Department of Health (department) considering amendments to several rules for the home care aide profession. This may include WACs <u>246-980-010</u>, <u>246-980-100</u>, <u>246-980-110</u>, <u>246-980-115</u>, and <u>246-980-140</u> in <u>Chapter 246-980 WAC</u>, <u>Home care aide rules</u>.

The department is considering amendments to the home care aide rules in response to the statutory changes made by <u>E2SHB 1694</u> and <u>E2SSB 5278</u>, both passed in 2023 legislative session. These bills focus on reducing barriers which keep home care aides from entering the workforce, encouraging retention, and improving the exam process. Other updates may also be made based on discussions with partners and interested parties.
