Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders and Tribal Partners:

SUBJECT: Transfer of public water systems within boundaries of tribal lands from Washington State Department of Health to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 10 Water Division under the Safe Drinking Water Act.

In accordance with chapter <u>43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and <u>DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure</u>, we are writing to inform you the Office of Drinking Water (ODW) at the Washington State Department of Health is working with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 10 (EPA) Water Division to initiate the transfer of oversight of public water systems (list enclosed) located entirely within tribal reservation boundaries.

EPA has sole authority for oversight of these water systems under the Safe Drinking Water Act. ODW and EPA developed a phased implementation process. In April 2023, two water systems were transferred to EPA within the Yakama Nation Tribal boundary. The next steps will include small batches of public water systems to accomplish the transfer of all public water systems within the boundaries of tribal lands within Washington State. The ongoing transfer of public water systems entirely within the boundaries of tribal lands will take multiple years to complete.

ODW will continue to communicate ahead of each phase of this transfer. We will send letters including detailed lists of water systems to each impacted tribe and the water system owners/operators based on the locational and contact information we have. These letters will be sent a minimum of 30 days before the transfer and will be copied to EPA. Such letters will provide additional information and consultation opportunities to the tribes impacted by each phase of this effort.
