

## HPV Vaccine Forecast

As of January 20, 2023, the Washington Immunization Information System accommodates the recommendation for the administration of the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series starting at age 9.

The [Certificate of Immunization Status \(CIS\)](#) will show HPV vaccines as ‘Recommended Vaccines (Not Required)’ for patients ages 9 and older.
