

Application Instructions Checklist

This application is submitted under <u>Public Law No. 117-333 Section 19</u>. You must hold an active chiropractic license in another state that is in good standing and in compliance with continuing education requirements (if applicable). All information should be printed clearly in blue or black ink. It is your responsibility to submit the correct required forms.

1. Demographic Information:

Important Social Security Number Information: If you have a Social Security Number, the law requires you to disclose it on your application for a professional or occupational license. 42 U.S.C. § 666(a)(13); RCW 26.23.150. It will be used under the state's child support enforcement program to locate individuals for purposes of establishing paternity and establishing, modifying, and enforcing support obligations. You are not required to have or obtain a Social Security Number to apply for or obtain a license from the Department of Health. If you do not have a Social Security Number, you are still eligible to apply for and obtain a credential if you meet the requirements. Please see the Declaration of No Social Security Number Form. Please call the Customer Service Center at 360-236-4700 if you have questions.

Legal Name: List your full name: first, middle, and last.

Definition of legal name: "Legal name" is the name appearing on your official certificate of birth or, if your name has changed since birth, on an official marriage certificate or an order by a court. The court must have the legal authority to change your name. We may ask you to prove your legal name.

Birth date: Provide the month, day, and year of your birth.

Address: List the address we should use to send any information about your credential. Be sure to include the city, state, zip code, county, and country. This will be your permanent address with the Chiropractic Quality Assurance Commission until we have been notified of a change.

Phone, Fax and Cell Numbers: Enter your phone, fax and cell numbers, if you have them.

Email: Enter your email address, if you have one.

2. Other License, Certification, or Registration: List all states, including Washington, where active credentials are held. Attach additional pages if you need more space.
3. Disciplinary Action Attestation: Required to be both initialed and dated in order to process the application.
4. Applicant's Attestation: Required to be both signed and dated in order to process the application.

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Documents to submit with your application should include the following:

A copy of your military orders
 OR

- A copy of your spouse or registered domestic partner's military transfer orders to Washington State; and
- One of the following:
 - A copy of your marriage certificate to show proof of marriage; or
 - A copy of a state's declaration or registration showing you are in a state registered domestic partnership with a member of the U.S. military.

Additional Information:

You will be mailed or emailed a letter regarding any additional information needed.
