





Parents and Guardians Registration Guide Let's get started!

Welcome to **Strong Start**, Washington state's Universal Developmental Screening System!

Strong Start helps to improve the health of children across the state, birth through age five. Families and health care providers can keep track of screenings, avoid missed or duplicated screenings, and access important information.

Parents, legal guardians, and licensed health care providers can register as users. Then they can enter and edit information.

This Registration Guide will help you set up your Strong Start account and keep track of your child's developmental screenings.

Identity Verification

Complete the **Identity Verification** step. You will be asked to complete this only once.

You will be asked a series of questions based on your public record data (the state of Washington does not gather or store this data). These questions could be about things you had or your professional experience. If you do not wish to answer these questions, you may request permission to skip this step. This choice may delay access to your service. Requests will send a notification to the owner of the service who may reach out to you to verify your identity manually. Once verified, you will be able to continue the registration process for the
