

WAIS User Training December 2023

Q: Can families access their child's Record after the [Immunizations] (and dates) are entered to WAIS from out of Country records?

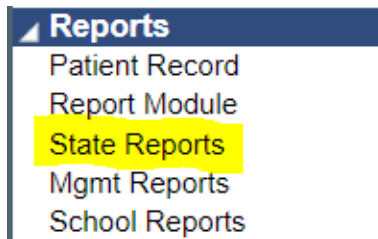
A: Yes, all vaccination information included in the patient record in the WAIS can be viewed/printed by individuals using MyIRMobile.com.

Q: How do immunization records from outside of WA state get entered into IIS?

A: Historical immunization records that were provided at another facility, including those given in another state/country may be entered by the current provider into the patient's record in the WAIS. Only medically verified immunizations should be included in the patient's WAIS record and historical vaccination records should be kept for verification purposes.

Q: Is there a way to get the vaccination record without a forecast?

A: Yes – The **Immunization Detail Record Report** can be found under **Reports > State Reports**



Q: Does WAIS include immunizations given at Madigan, the VA, or Tribal clinics?

A: If the provider participates with the IIS and submits the immunization record to the WAIS it will show as part of the patient record. Many tribal clinics participate with the IIS as well as AMC Madigan and the VA.
