



## **POP Provider Survey Results**

### **Highlights**


In Summer 2023, the Power of Providers (POP) Initiative administered a survey among providers who were currently signed up for POP. The purpose of the survey was to understand providers' experiences as members of POP and identify potential areas for improvement and growth as a program. A total of 286 providers completed the survey. This report includes highlights from the survey findings. More in-depth findings will be included in an evaluation report due later this year.

71% of providers agreed or strongly agreed that the information and resources offered through POP have increased their confidence in encouraging COVID-19 vaccination with their patients.

#### The information and resources offered through POP have...




# POP helps providers feel more connected to DOH and to other providers.
