Providing breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to eligible people in Washington

We serve people who:

- Don't have health insurance or have a high deductible.
- Have low income.
- Meet the age guidelines.

Services include:

- Breast cancer screenings (breast exams and mammograms).
- Cervical cancer screenings (Pap and HPV tests).
- Follow-up tests as needed, based on screening results.
- Assistance with navigating resources for treatment if needed.
