



## HB 1470: PRIVATE DETENTION FACILITIES Rules Advisory Committee Help Needed

We are looking for 2-3 community members to join our team and write rules for how private detention facilities care for the health and safety of detainees.

- Being on the Rules Advisory Committee (RAC) requires about 2 hours of work per week on average from March through May attending virtual meetings and reviewing documents
- The RAC is open to the public. This includes advocates, regulated parties, and community members. Membership is not anonymous
- Members join multiple meetings to draft rules governing the health and safety of private detention facilities' detainees

## Rulemaking is a public process

- Our goal is to listen to as many people as possible when we create new rules. The law requires the process of making rules to be public and tells state agencies what they must do to make rules
