Due to factors such as client relocation during FFY2023, approximately $4.6 \%$ clients are likely counted as participating in more than one agency.

Total Food Dollars Redeemed - This includes all food purchased with WIC checks during FFY2023, including fresh fruits and vegetables. This does not include WIC Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) dollars, which is a separate grant.

Total Food Dollars for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables only - Fresh fruit and vegetable dollars are a subset of Total Food Dollars Redeemed during FFY2023. Neither include FMNP dollars.
