

Background

> 2023 RECOMMENDATIONS

2023 Legislative Recommendations (adopted as part of <u>E2SHB 2247</u> during the 2024 legislative session)

Masters Level Counselors (SW, MFT, MHC)

Remove limits on renewals for associate licenses

For MFT, reduce the 5-year experience requirement to supervise associates to align with other professions

Allow applicants for associate license to continue providing care to established patients while their application is pending

Align master's level provider CE requirements with other professions by moving the specific hour requirements to rule.

Adopt the social work compact (Not included in 2247, adopted by SHB 1939)

Psychology

Establish an associate credential for psychology trainees

Allow EBOP to create standards for licensure without exam that reflect the reality of the applicant's professional experience

Substance Use Disorder Professionals

Remove limits on renewals for trainee licenses

Remove practice location restrictions on SUDP trainees

Remove the time limit for earning supervised experience hours

Other recommendations

Allow AAC to practice in Federally Qualified Health Centers (effective 2028)

2023 Rulemaking Recommendations



Substance Use Disorder Providers

- Reduce CE hour requirements
- Reduce the number of years of licensure in a substantially-equivalent state required for licensure by endorsement
- Modify coursework review requirements so review is only required if the applicant did not complete a SUD counseling program with a degree
- Reduce years of practice required to supervise SUDP trainees
- Allow supervisors to provide remote supervision after the first 50 hours of training

2023 Rulemaking Recommendations



Masters Level Counselors

- Reduce CE hour requirements
- Allow professional experience to substitute for practicum requirements
- Reduce the number of years of licensure in a substantially-equivalent state required for licensure by endorsement



Psychology

- Increase the number of courses that can be completed outside the doctoral program
- Reduce the number of residency hours required
- Allow graduates from programs accredited by the Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System to undergo the same simplified review as APA accredited programs

- What licensing or credentialing barriers exist that prevent providers from entering or staying in the behavioral health workforce?

- What other licensing or credentialing related barriers does the department need to be aware of and consider?
- ¿Qué otros obstáculos debe tener en cuenta o considerar el departamento acerca de la obtención de autorización o credenciales?

Next Steps

- Staff will review all comments received during listening sessions or in writing, perform any needed research, and draft preliminary recommendations.
- DOH will then hold more virtual sessions to review the draft recommendations and get feedback from interested parties
 - Anticipated timeframe: July/August 2024
- Present final recommendations to the legislature in November 2024.
