I am pleased to announce that the department has filed the CR102 for the proposed draft rules for Organ Transport Services WAC 246-976-360 ([WSR 24-11-155](#)). The public notice and proposed rules can be found on the DOH website [here](#).

The department is collecting comments on the proposed revisions and will consider adopting the rules following the public hearing on **June 25, 2024**. If you are unable to attend the hearing, all comments and questions are welcome from the public until 5pm on June 25, 2024. The primary purpose of this rulemaking was to create licensing requirements for organ transport services and vehicles in response to legislative requirements under Substitute House Bill (SHB) 1271 (chapter 290, Laws of 2023) to establish the minimum standards for organ transport vehicles and equipment in WAC 246-976-360.

Organ Transport Services and Vehicles rules were opened July 2023. The Department of Health held two stakeholder meetings between September 2023 and October 2023.

We would like to thank all the stakeholders who participated with us in this work.
