

## 2024 Legislation

- In 2024 Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 2247 passed. This bill established a new credential, the psychological associate license.
- The bill also gave the board authority to waive requirements for applicants who had continuously held a license in another jurisdiction for a period of time that renders the waived requirements duplicative or unnecessary (board to decide what that period of time would be).
