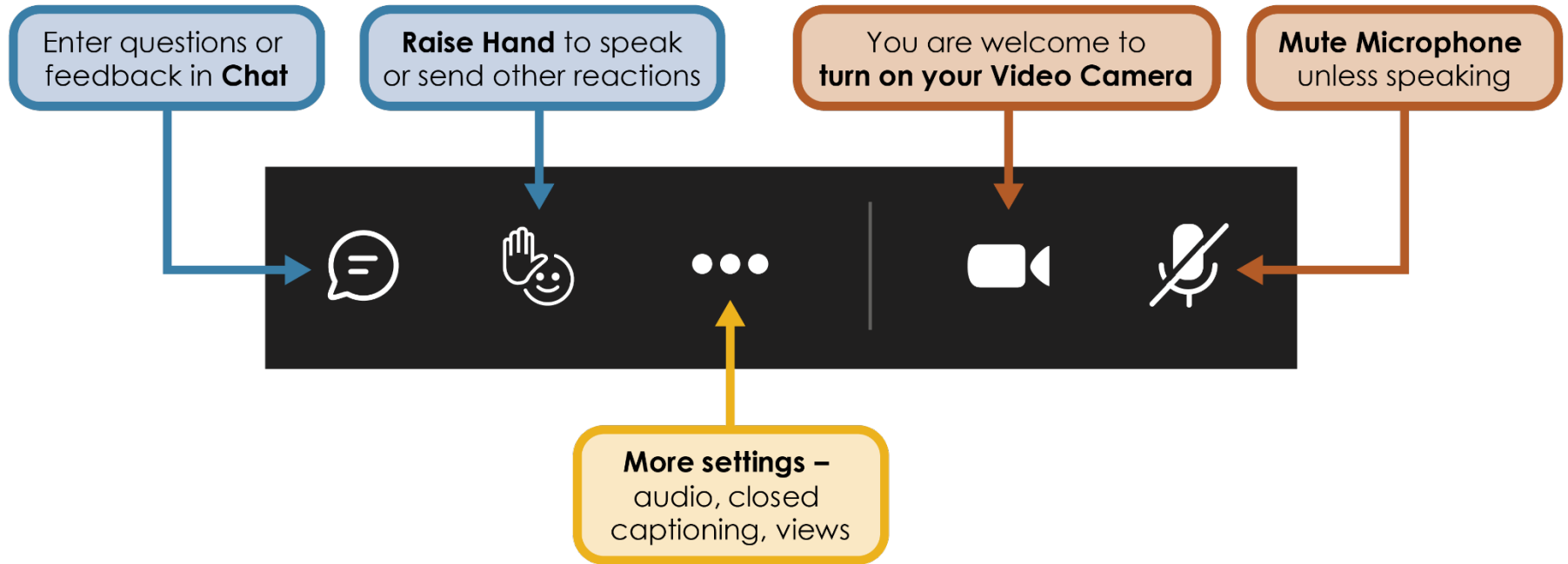

EPPP

- Currently EPPP exam is one multiple-choice knowledge exam.
- The EPPP2 is a skills-based exam that is currently optional.
- Starting January 1, 2026 the EPPP will become one exam with two parts, Part 1 – Knowledge and Part 2 – Skills.

Questions

- With the upcoming new psychological associate credential, some public comments said it would be nice for those with this credential to receive authorization to take the EPPP at that point instead of waiting for current practice which is after all licensing requirements have been met.
- Once the EPPP becomes a two part exam, and if the board allows psychological associates to receive authorization to take the EPPP, should this authorization be for both parts or should Part 1 occur during the associate level and Part 2 after licensing requirements have been met?
- Any criteria that should be met before they are authorized to take both parts?
