

WIC PROGRAM CURRENT OR FUTURE VENDORS: COME SHARE!



The Department of Health wants to hear from current tribal WIC grocery vendors (“vendors”) and from tribal stores which don’t currently participate. We are updating the rules for WIC vendors, and we want to know how those rules affect you. We also want to learn how we can make it easier for stores to become authorized WIC vendors.

To make it easier for a variety of vendors to participate, we aim to:

- Increase access to stores that offer WIC benefits
- Increase the variety of stores that offer WIC benefits
- Allow “WIC-Only” vendors


