Fatherhood Council can help make connection</li> <li>○ That is fantastic so we will be able to disaggregate the data by gender of parent!</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Regional definition <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 4 big counties (Snohomish, Pierce, Spokane, Clark) and then all other counties in regions (4 total).</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Survey launch anticipated Summer 2024</li> <li>● Slides have been shared and are on our PRAMS website</li> </ul> <p><b><u>PRAMS Qualitative Analysis of Backpage Comments</u></b></p> <p>Approximately 20% of PRAMS respondents from WA provide additional backpage comments. Presenters shared their analysis of these comments.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Clarification that these comments include comments in margins.</li> <li>● Interested to see how COVID changes things</li> <li>● Suggestions to share with provider communities since comments about experiences with providers were prevalent</li> <li>● Rural areas with few birthing centers – Medicaid expansion and how effective cost</li> <li>● How to get access to comments</li> <li>● County perspective – resonates – infant care – reliable/affordable/prenatal support/mental health</li> </ul>
