



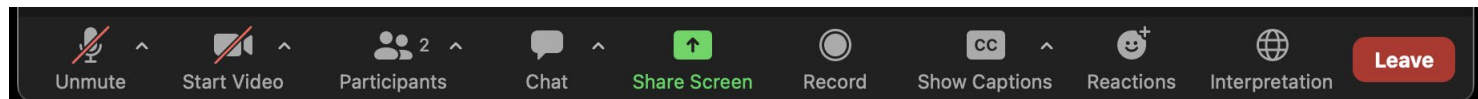

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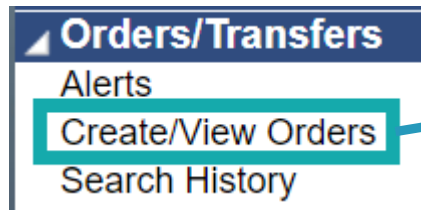

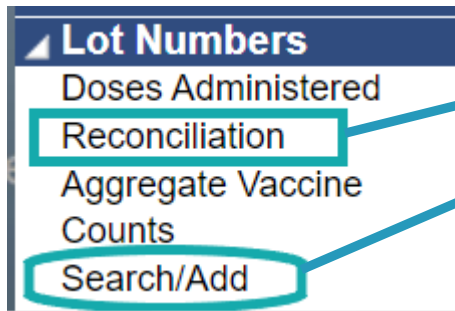

IIS Inventory

- For clinics that receive state supplied vaccine, inventory is typically added to a facility's IIS inventory through receiving an order or transfer in the IIS.
- Products can be directly added into IIS inventory, but this is usually done to add privately purchased stock.



→ **Create/View Orders** page to receive orders/transfers



→ **Reconciliation** page shows active lots

→ **Search/Add** - lookup details of lot numbers and make edits, find inactive lots, add new inventory items

Understanding Your Order Status

Status	Detail
Saved	The order was started and saved, but not submitted. Saved orders can be submitted by clicking the arrow button to open the order and then selecting Submit . You may also delete the order if you do not want to submit.
In Manual Review	The order was submitted and is awaiting DOH review.
Pending Approval	The order is being reviewed by approver and is waiting to be submitted to the state.
State Manual Review	The order is waiting for state approval.
Pending State Approval	The order is waiting for state review and approval.
Shipped	The order was shipped and is in route to the provider. Shipments can be received into inventory when an order status says shipped.
Received	The order was electronically received by the provider in the IIS. The provider's inventory (Reconciliation screen) is automatically updated with the received vaccines. The order is removed from the inbound orders list and can be viewed using the search history function.
Archived	Historical orders are archived by the state and removed from the inbound orders list. Archived orders can be viewed using the search history function.
Backordered	The order is temporarily held by the state. These orders are not yet processed for shipment.
Denied	The order is not approved and the vaccines in the order are not processed for shipment. The provider can delete the denied order.
Approved	The order has been approved by the state and has yet to be sent for fulfillment.

IIS Inventory Decrementing

“decrement”

- a process of becoming smaller in quantity or quality (noun)
- the amount by which something decreases (noun)
- to cause a reduction in numerical quantity (verb)
- to subtract, especially in consecutive counting (verb)

Antonym: ***increment***

“When a vaccine dose is administered, that dose decrements from the clinic’s vaccine inventory by one unit.”

IIS Inventory Decrementing

- The vaccine product should be active in the IIS inventory prior to the vaccination date. A dose cannot decrement from a lot number that does not exist as an active product in the IIS inventory.
- The vaccine should be newly administered. For decrementing to occur when vaccination events are received by the IIS via HL7 message from an EHR, certain data elements need to match between the clinic's electronic health record system and the facility's IIS inventory.
- Decrementing and incrementing of IIS vaccine stock occurs when adjustments are made during the reconciliation process.

IIS Inventory Decrementing

- When a vaccine dose is recorded with the necessary data elements in place, the dose decrements from the facility's IIS inventory 'quantity on hand'.
- When a new vaccination is recorded directly into the IIS, the ["Click to Select"](#) link should be clicked in the 'Vaccination Detail Add' page to choose the active inventory product administered from the popup that appears. This will cause the dose to decrement from the IIS inventory when the vaccination is saved.

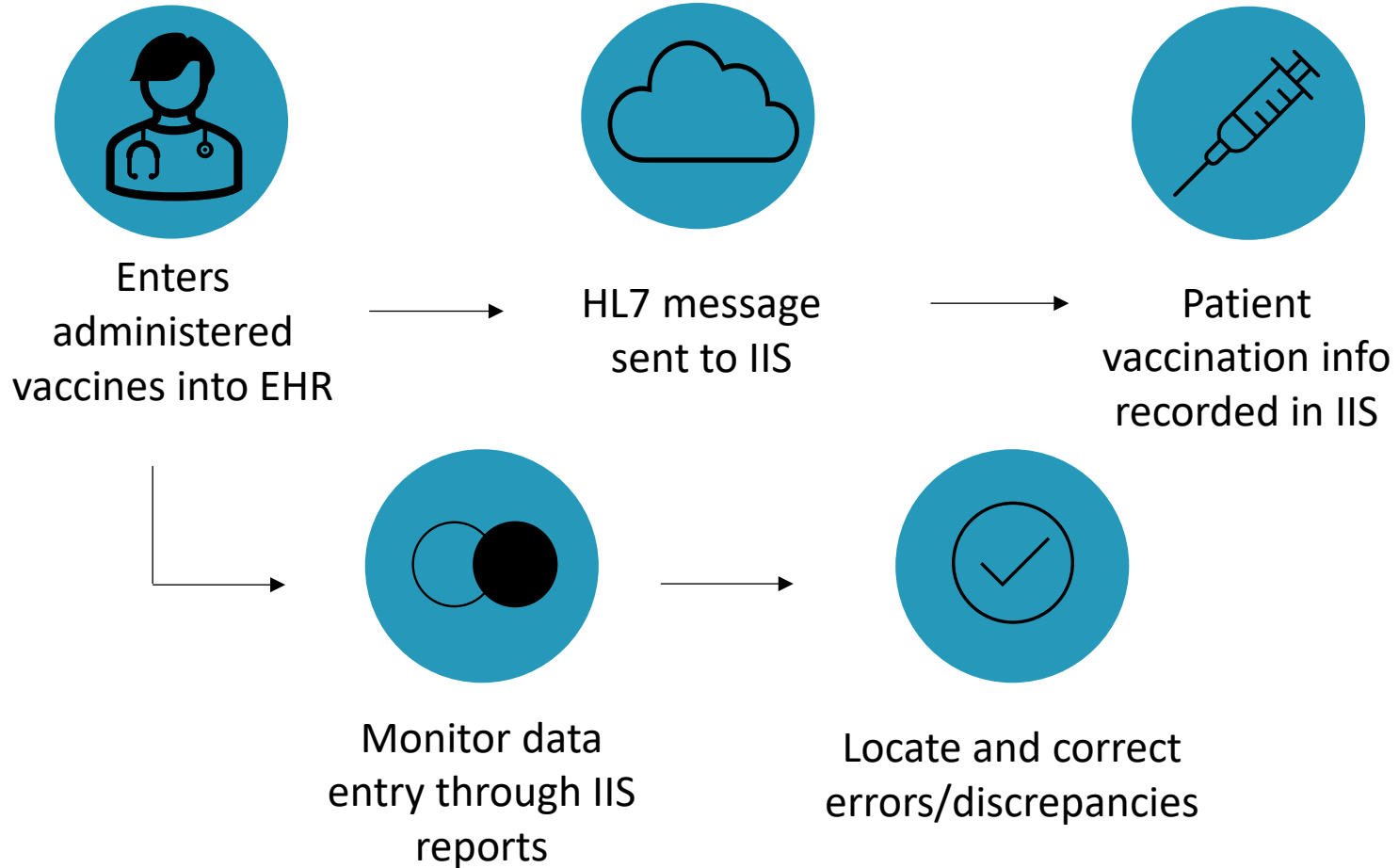
IIS Inventory Decrementing

Administered vaccines are those provided by your clinic now or in the past.

Historical vaccines were administered by another provider but entered by your clinic based on a medically verified record.

Vaccination Date and Product **cannot** be edited. If either of these were entered incorrectly, delete the record and re-enter with the correct information.

Vaccines Reported from an EHR



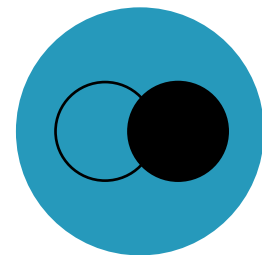
Matching

The following must be the same between EHR and IIS:

- Product
- Lot Number
- Manufacturer
- Funding Source (Public vs. Private)

***Document lot numbers from the box of the vaccine, *not* the vial/syringe.**

****Check for incorrect entries – I vs. 1, O vs. 0, L vs. 1, etc.**



Matching

These data elements must match exactly between the EHR system and the active IIS inventory for the vaccine product administered:

- Lot Number (exact match – no spaces or typos)
- Manufacturer
- Vaccine Product (CVX code tells the WAIS which product was used)
- Funding Source (Public or Private)

Timing

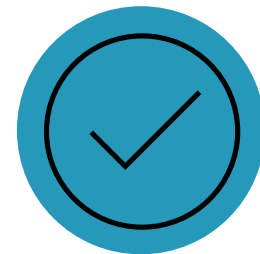
- Lots administered to a patient must be present and active in your IIS inventory prior to the vaccination date
- Orders/transfers must be received in the IIS prior to administering the vaccines



***Do not receive an order and then manually add the lot numbers or your inventory will be doubled**

Accuracy

- ✓ Correct and Complete Documentation
 - ✓ **Product**
 - ✓ **Patient**
 - ✓ **Vaccination Event / Vaccine Inventory**
- ✓ Use one lot at a time and make sure you type or select the correct lot number in your EHR.
- ✓ Ensure staff are logged into the correct facility



IIS Inventory Reconciliation

- After troubleshooting and completing corrections, go to **Lot Numbers>Reconciliation** in the WAIS.
- Enter the quantity of vaccine you have in your clinic in the ‘Physical Inventory’ box for each line item.
- Select the Category and Reason for any discrepancies.
 - Click the + button in the ‘Add Row’ column to enter more than one type of Category and Reason
- Click ‘Save’ at the bottom right of the page. While you can reconcile and save your work more often, ‘Submit Monthly Inventory’ once per month.

IIS Inventory Reconciliation

- When a clinic reconciles inventory in the IIS, the facility's IIS inventory can be decremented or incremented, depending on physical vaccine counts.

IIS Inventory Reconciliation

- Must be completed monthly prior to submitting inventory to DOH for publicly supplied vaccines
 - We recommend weekly reconciliation, but inventory only needs to be submitted monthly
- Print the reconciliation page from the WAIS
- Take counts of the vaccine that is physically in your clinic
- Troubleshoot discrepancies and make corrections so that administered doses pull from your IIS inventory
- If indicated, make corrections in your EHR and resubmit the vaccination data to the WAIS
 - In some cases, corrections will need to be made directly in the WAIS

Troubleshooting with Reports

[Lot Usage and Recall Report](#) – Identifies all patients who have received a vaccine with a certain lot number within a given time frame

[Patient Detail Report](#) - Easily identify missing/incorrect information for vaccination records submitted to the IIS.

[Provider Detail Error Report](#) – Shows warnings and errors in immunization data sent from an EHR to the IIS.

- Errors identify messages that were not received by the IIS
- Warnings indicate missing data, often causing a dose not to decrement
- This report is scheduled to go to a designated person in your organization on a recurring basis

Troubleshooting with Reports

The [Patient Detail Report](#) is helpful in determining missing or mismatched data elements. Use it to find missing or mismatched data elements to make the necessary corrections.
