Applicant, Project Description, and Estimated Capital Cost:

Virginia Mason Franciscan Health proposes to establish an Adult Elective Percutaneous Coronary Intervention (PCI) Program at St. Francis Hospital within King County. The estimated cost for this project is \$0.

Public Hearing: No public hearing will be held unless requested. To request a hearing, the request must be in writing and include the name, address, and signature of the person making the request. The deadline for requesting a hearing is **Monday, October 28, 2024**. If a public hearing is scheduled, the hearing notice will be published in The Seattle Times at least 15 days before the date of hearing.

Public Comment Period: If no public hearing is held, written comments must be received by the Certificate of Need Program on or before <u>Friday</u>, <u>November 15</u>, <u>2024</u>.
