## Re: Collaborative – Request for Proposals from the Shellfish Strategic Initiative Lead (SIL) invested through EPA Puget Sound Geographic Program funds

Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners and Professionals:

We are writing today to provide information about a funding opportunity to increase harvestable shellfish bed acreage in Puget Sound. Approximately \$5.3M will be invested through <u>EPA Puget</u> <u>Sound Geographic Program funds</u> request for proposals (RFP) process.

This communication follows the guidelines of <u>Chapter 43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State</u> <u>Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and the <u>DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure</u>. The Department administers these federal funds through a cooperative agreement with the EPA <u>RFP</u> that targets four investment priorities that were identified by an Advisory Team to the Shellfish SIL. The priorities solicited for aim to make progress towards the <u>Shellfish Beds Vital Sign</u> <u>target</u> which strives for a net increase in harvestable shellfish beds in Puget Sound. Investments will be prioritized in areas with potential acreage gain or in areas threatened to be downgraded on the <u>Threatened Growing Area List</u>. Prioritization will also be given to investments that integrate Tribal Treaty Rights, climate change adaptation and resilience strategies, and environmental justice.
