Re: Informative- ESHB 1503 implementation – collecting demographic data from health care professionals

Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners and Professionals:

We are writing today to provide information about the Department of Health's implementation of <u>ESHB 1503</u> requiring the collection of demographic data from health care professionals at the time of licensure and renewals.

This communication follows the guidelines of <u>Chapter 43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State</u> <u>Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and the <u>DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure</u>. We are informing you that beginning on January 1, 2025, state law requires the department to collect applicant information, including race and ethnicity, when an applicant applies, or a licensee renews, their health care professional license. The race and ethnicity data must be collected according to the <u>United States Department of Education 2007 Race and Ethnicity Reporting Guidelines</u>, as stipulated in <u>RCW 28A.300.042</u>. American Indian/Alaska Native is included in the race category but does not include tribal affiliation.
