In accordance with chapter <u>43.376 RCW</u>, the <u>Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989</u>, and <u>DOH Consultation</u> <u>and Collaboration Procedure</u>, we write to invite collaboration to participate in **two listening sessions within the Office of Health and Science at the WA-DOH.** 

We recognize that it is vital for Tribes and Urban programs to have the opportunity to influence how data reflect the priorities that matter most to your communities. As we continue to develop our Tribal data sovereignty policies and principles, we also seek to create space to collaborate on data reporting. Your input is essential to ensuring that **Healthy Youth Survey (HYS)** and **State Health Assessment** reporting accurately reflect the needs and values of Indigenous populations in Washington.
