- WAC 246-945-345 <u>Noncontrolled prescription transfers</u>. (1) ((Subsections (2) through (5) of this section apply to the transfer of prescription information for noncontrolled drugs. The transfer of controlled substance prescription information must conform to the requirements of 21 C.F.R. Sec. 1306.25.
- $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$) Upon <u>request by a patient ((request)) or an authorized representative of a patient</u>, a <u>noncontrolled</u> prescription ((may)) <u>shall</u> be transferred within the limits of state and federal law.
- (2) Pharmacies shall transfer noncontrolled prescription information within three business days of receiving the request or within a time frame that does not adversely impact the provision of medication therapy, whichever comes first.
- (3) Sufficient information needs to be exchanged in the transfer of a <u>noncontrolled</u> prescription to maintain an auditable trail, and all elements of a valid prescription.
- (4) Pharmacies sharing a secure real-time database are not required to transfer <u>noncontrolled</u> prescription information for dispensing.
- (5) <u>Noncontrolled prescriptions</u> must be transferred by electronic means or facsimile, except in emergent situations.

NEW SECTION

WAC 246-945-346 Controlled substance prescription transfers. (1) Upon request by a patient or an authorized representative of the patient, a controlled substance prescription shall be transferred within the limits of state and federal law including, but not limited

to, the requirements of 21 C.F.R. Secs. 1306.08 and 1306.25.

(2) Pharmacies shall transfer controlled substance prescription information within three business days of receiving the request or within a time frame that does not adversely impact the provision of medication therapy, whichever comes first.
