Re: Collaborative- Overdose Data to Action in States – Develop or Expand Overdose Prevention

Greetings Honorable Tribal Leaders, Partners, and Professionals:

In accordance with chapter [43.376 RCW](#), the [Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989](#), and [DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure](#), we invite collaboration with Indian tribes and tribal organizations for the implementation of a new grant through the DOH Injury and Violence Prevention (IVP) Program.

DOH seeks to fund up to seven eligible Tribal Nations, organizations, and communities to develop or expand community-led overdose prevention activities in American Indian/Alaska Native communities. **The funding application will be open from January 21- March 3, 2025.** We are also seeking Tribal representatives to join the application scoring panel; if interested please respond to the contact below by February 17, 2025. Please note that serving as a representative on the panel will make your tribe or organization ineligible to apply for this funding. Estimated funding ranges per grantee: Year 1: \$64,943 to \$90,920 plus a one-time federal enhancement up to \$50,000; Years 2-4: \$45,895 to \$64,253
