In accordance with WAC 246-310-080, Seattle Children's hereby submits this Letter of Intent to establish an ambulatory surgery center in Federal Way, in the Southeast King County Secondary Health Services Planning Area. In conformance with WAC, the following information is provided:

1. A Description of the Extent of Services Proposed:

Seattle Children's proposes to establish an ambulatory surgery center in the Secondary Health Services Planning Area. The proposed ambulatory surgery center will have three operating rooms to provide outpatient surgical services to pediatric patients.

2. Estimated Cost of the Proposed Project:

The estimated capital expenditure is \$31,000,000.

3. Description of the Service Area:

Per WAC 246-310-270, the primary service area is the Southeast King County Secondary Health Services Planning Area. However, because Seattle Children's serves as the pediatric and adolescent academic medical center for Washington, Alaska, Montana, and Idaho, Seattle Children's anticipates patients will also come from other areas of King County as well as Pierce, Kitsap, Thurston, and other counties throughout Western Washington.
