In accordance with chapter [43.376 RCW](#), the [Washington State Centennial Accord of 1989](#), and [DOH Consultation and Collaboration Procedure](#), we invite collaboration on [draft language](#) aimed at reforming data sharing practices for the 2026 legislative session.

As shared in our [Informative DTLL](#) sent December 3, 2024, this draft language seeks to address long-standing barriers to sharing critical public health data with Tribal governments and Tribal Epidemiology Centers (TECs) in a timely and effective manner. The draft language has been developed as a starting point to guide discussions for our listening sessions, where we invite you to collaborate with us on developing the language for the 2026 legislative session.
