What is TodaysBaby?

- ◆ The TodaysBabyTM Programs contain up-todate information on baby sleep, baby feeding, or baby-parent interactions.
- ◆ Participants receive baby care information in the form of short videos, delivered via private Facebook groups.
- Researchers are interested in learning what parts of the TodaysBabyTM programs are best at helping parents to make the best decisions about caring for their baby.

What will happen if I choose to participate?

- You will receive free baby care educational videos and messages throughout your pregnancy and until your new baby is 6 months old.
- You will complete surveys and answer text message questions about how you plan to take care of your baby.
- ♦ You will receive up to \$50 in gift cards to thank you for your time.

You may be eligible to participate if:

- ♦ You are at least 18 years old
- ◆ You are currently pregnant and less than30 weeks along.
